3	<p><b>INVESTIGATION and INQUEST</b></p> <p>On 27<sup>th</sup> May 2013 I commenced an investigation into the death of Kevin Scarlett. The investigation concluded at the end of the inquest on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2014 The conclusion of the inquest sitting with a jury was a narrative conclusion that</p> <p>On 22nd May 2013 Kevin Scarlett was found in cell 101 at HMP Woodhill, Milton Keynes hanging from a bunk using a sheet as a ligature and died as a result of an accident.</p> <p>The circumstances are: as above</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) That Kevin's risk of self harm or suicide was not properly assessed</li><li>b) That is was appropriate for Kevin to be on a 'basic regime'</li><li>c) That it was inappropriate for Kevin to be alone in a double room/cell</li><li>d) That Kevin should have been allocated to a safer cell</li><li>e) That Kevin should have been subject to enhanced case management</li></ol>
