2	CORONER'S LEGAL POWERS
	I make this report under paragraph 7, Schedule 5, of the Coroners and Justice Act 2009 and regulations 28 and 29 of the Coroners (Investigations) Regulations 2013.
3	INVESTIGATION and INQUEST
	On 18 December 2017 I commenced an investigation into the death of Neil JONES 26 years old. The investigation concluded at the end of the inquest on 25 May 2018. The conclusion of the inquest was that Mr Jones died as the result of a Road Traffic Collision
4	CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE DEATH
	Mr Jones was attended the Bel Air nightclub at the Belfry Resort. He was ejected from the nightclub due to his intoxicated condition. He was hit by vehicle at about 1.30am on the A446 outside the Belfry Resort.
5	CORONER'S CONCERNS
	During the course of the inquest the evidence revealed matters giving rise to concern. In my opinion there is a risk that future deaths will occur unless action is taken. In the circumstances it is my statutory duty to report to you.
	The MATTERS OF CONCERN are as follows
	(1) There have been 4 (four) fatal road traffic collisions at this site over 10 years despite a reduction in the speed limit to 50 mph.in 2008.I am aware that the site is being considered as a casualty reduction scheme although I understand no final decision has been made.
6	ACTION SHOULD BE TAKEN
	In my opinion action should be taken to prevent future deaths and I believe you as Chief Executive of Warwickshire County Council have the power to take such action.
