1. On 4/1/22 this court committed the following named person to prison

3. which provided that the Respondent/ Defendant is forbidden from:

**(A) Engaging in conduct causing or capable of causing nuisance, annoyance, harassment, alarm or distress to any person in the locality of, residing in, or engaged in lawful activity in (a) 73 Coventry Road, London, E1 5RG, or (b) 85 Cudworth Street, London E1 5QU or (c) King's Building, 16 Smith Square, London SW1P 3HQ, such behaviour to include using racist language.**

**And**

**(B) Entering or remaining within any part of 85 Cudworth Street, London E1 5QU or the immediate area surrounding 85 Cudworth Street as shown on the attached map.**

4. the court found that he had breached that order by

- i) Entering or being in the area immediately surrounding 85 Cudworth Street, London E1 5QU on 2/8/21, 11/9/21, 13/10/21, 10/11/21.**
- ii) Engaging in a loud, aggressive and distressing argument with Ms Musa outside 73 Coventry Road on 7/9/21, this being conduct capable of causing nuisance, annoyance, harassment, alarm and distress to Ms Musa and others at the address.**

5. and imposed the following sentence(s) for those breach(es)

Accordingly it was ordered that<sup>(2)</sup> Jonathan Easterbrook be committed for contempt to prison for a (total) period of 12 weeks.

The order is suspended until 30 June 2023 and will not be put into force if during that time<sup>(2)</sup> Jonathan Easterbrook complies with the injunction order dated 28 June 2021, the duration of which was extended to 30 June 2023.
