In relation to F05MA163 on Monday 15th February 2021, at the County Court at Manchester, 1 Bridge Street West, Manchester, M60 9DJ, before District Judge Judge Moss sentenced Ian Calderley-Harper to an immediate custodial sentence of 54 days for contempt of Court.

The basis of that sentence was that he breached the Injunction Order & Power of Arrest dated the 14th May 2020 on the 21st December 2020 by breaching Clause 4 by present inside the Tesco Store on Market Street, Manchester; On 9 January 2021 at around 9am the Defendant used violence and caused alarm and distress to a security guard working at the Co-op on Corporation Street, Manchester, being a breach of clauses 1 and 3; On 9 January 2021 at around 9.15am the Defendant harassed and caused alarm and distress to a security guard working at Marks and Spencer on Market Street, by saying 'Get off me you black bastard' to him, in breach of clauses 1 and 2 and on 13 February 2021 at around 5.40pm the Defendant was present outside Urban Outfitters on Market Street, Manchester, in breach of clause 4.
