1. On the 8 October 2020 this court committed the following named person to prison

2. In relation to an order dated

5 August 2020

3. which provided (inter alia) that the Defendant should not

- i) attend the home address of.... Any member of the claimant's children services team...**
- ii) contact directly or indirectly any member of the claimant's children services team other than by mutually agreed appointment or as directed by the court or via a legal representative and only with regard to current family court proceedings**
- iii) engage in conduct capable of causing a nuisance or annoyance to anyone at any time ... such conduct including but not being limited to threats, intimidation and/or assaults... towards any member of the claimant's children service team or their legal representatives**

4. the court found that the Defendant had breached that order in attending at the home of a member of the Claimant's children services team on 7 September 2020 and in contacting said member on that occasion and in engaging in conduct capable of causing said member nuisance or annoyance.

5. and imposed the following sentence(s) for those breach(es)

breach	Sentence
as above	405 days (with 30 days credit for time already served on remaned)

6. Accordingly it was ordered that⁽²⁾ Mark Mullany

be committed for contempt to Her Majesty's Prison at⁽³⁾ Highdown for a (total) period of 405 days or until lawfully discharged if sooner
