On 14 May 2020 Ian Calderley-Harper was found in Contempt of Court (on his own admission) for having wilfully breached the Order of 16 October 2019 varied on 3 December 2019 and further varied on 12 March 2020 in that on various dates between 26 November 2019 and 29 April 2020 Ian Calderley-Harper breached the orders by being present in an area he was prohibited from attending and causing harassment, alarm and distress. There were a total of 11 breaches, for which he was sentenced to a total of 372 Days.

It was Ordered That Ian Calderley-Harper be committed for contempt to Her Majesty's Prison for a total period of 372 Days, or until lawfully discharged if sooner.
