

<u>Transparency Implementation Group (draft terms of reference)</u>

To support the President in the implementation of the reforms set out in his Transparency Review report over a period of 12-18 months, primarily by the following means:

- Creation of sub-committees/ working groups to focus on five separate but overlapping streams of work:
 - Allowing journalists and legal bloggers into court and to report what they see
 including
 - Identifying locations for and setting up the pilots in the review document
 - Refining arrangements for access to documents and information and attendance at hearings, including listing
 - o Publication of judgments, including anonymisation
 - Data
 - Media, including
 - Setting up the media liaison committee(s)
 - Annual report
 - o Financial Remedies Court proceedings
- By making such recommendations to the FPRC or other bodies as may be appropriate and necessary to facilitate the reforms
- And generally by leading and supporting cultural change amongst family justice system professionals and other interested stakeholders, through training, guidance and other means

And to do so using a transparent process.
